



Hi, I'm Melissa from NorthlineExpress, and I'm here today with our Mosquito Magnet Independence Mode. And I'm also here to tell you about the great bundle we've got going on right now with the Mosquito Magnet Independence. Right now you're going to purchase a Mosquito Magnet Independence and get three free accessories. We're going to throw in an extra mosquito Octenol Baits which is going to give you enough protection all summer long and a free handheld zapper.

Let's talk a little bit about the Mosquito Magnet Independence itself. The Mosquito Magnet Independence is a cordless mosquito trap, which is convenient because you do need to place it on the edge of your outdoor living space or the property you're trying to protect from the mosquitoes. So using the propane rather than having a cord makes it easy to place your mosquito trap every time. It's an important factor in the way the mosquito trap works.

The propane is going to combine with the Octenol bait that the trap uses, and create a plume of CO2 that's going to come out of the unit and actually trick those female mosquitoes, who are the biters, into thinking that there's a human or animal over here that they're going to feast on.

Now this unit is going to provide immediate results. Once you turn this unit on and get it all set up, it's going to immediately attract those mosquitoes. Within seven to the days you're going to start to notice dramatic results, and in about for weeks you're going to notice almost a complete reduction because that breeding cycle has been absolutely or pretty much reduced.

The way the breeding cycle is interrupted is because it's attracting those female mosquitoes to the unit because they're actually who do the biting. So once the female mosquitoes are mostly caught, the male mosquitoes are going to move elsewhere because there aren't any females around. And you know what the males are looking for when they're trying to find the females, they're trying to reproduce. So they're going to go elsewhere to find those female mosquitoes. The females on your property, they're going to be attracted to the unit, and they're going to be caught.

This unit does provide up to an acre of coverage. So it's great for those of you who have larger outdoor living spaces or you've got a larger area of property with wet swampy areas on it, this is when you need the perfect trap for use. The unit also has the capability to use two different types of bait. The unit's going to come with Octenol, which is great for the average type of mosquito which is out usually early morning in the dawn and then again at dusk when it starts to be sunset time of day. And during the day they're not really out, but in the shady areas you'll start to run into them.

So the Octenol is going to work well for the common mosquito, but there's also the option of using Lurex. Lurex is a little bit stronger base that's more focused on catching and attracting those Asian tiger mosquitoes. The best way to determine if you've got Asian tiger mosquitoes would be to actually catch one and take a closer look at it. They're a little bit larger, and they have those tiger-like stripes on them, but it's not very often that you get very close to a mosquito to actually determine which type you're seeing. So another great way to tell is by actually paying attention to the activity of the mosquito. Asian tiger mosquitoes really don't care what time of day it is, or how hot it is. They're going to be out all day long, whether it's super sunny and super-hot or it's just an average day like today. They're going to be out, and they're going bite all day long. That's one of the best determining factors in deciding which type of mosquito you've got.

Now let's get into the details of how this unit works. So as you can see here, the unit has counter flow technology, Counter flow technology is actually how the unit functions. The unit is going to, at the same time it's creating that CO2 flume, and it has a powerful fan on the unit that is going to suck in any mosquitoes that are attracted to the unit up inside the unit and into the catch bag that is located on top of the unit. Once the mosquitoes are sucked into the unit, they're going to be held inside the catch bag.

One of my favorite features about this unit is I don't really have to touch or do to determine when my catch bag is full. They have this nice clear cover on the top of the unit that is see-through so you can see the bag without having to open it up. And when it's time to change out the mosquito net, it's actually very easy to get to, and it's also going to provide protection from the rain.

The first thing we're giving free with this is an extra catch bag, and that's because when we use this unit we're actually at the owner's house right now. He put this up and within two days he had to change out his catch bag it was so full. And it's important you don't let your catch bag get too full because it can affect the air flow of the unit which is going to cause your unit to be less effective.

Usually you can just take your catch bag out, dump it out, and start over, but sometimes if your unit is being very effective and filling up very fast, you might not have had a chance to let those mosquitoes dehydrate and die, So we've thrown in an extra catch bag so that you can pull that extra catch bag out, tighten it up, set it aside so that the mosquitoes can dehydrate and die, and at the same time you can put a fresh catch bag into your unit and continue to catch mosquitoes.

Now you don't want to just dump it out when that full catch bag, the reason you want to let that dehydrate and die, if you just dump them out and they're still alive, they're going to go right back into that environment. You would be defeating the whole purpose of the mosquito trap in the first place.

The second thing we're giving you with it is a free pack of Octenol baits. Now with the Octenol that comes with the unit and the additional free three pack we're throwing in, that's pretty much going to

provide you a whole summer of mosquito protection. Each one of the Octenol baits is recommended that you change it out every three to four weeks. You'll be able to determine when it's time to change it, whether it'll be closer to the three or the four weeks by the activity of the mosquitoes. If you start to notice they're dying off or they're not attracted, it's probably time to change out the Octenol in there.

The third thing we're giving you is a free handheld insect zapper. Now you're probably saying, why do I need a handheld insect zapper if this unit is going to take care of my mosquito problem? It is going to take care of your mosquito problem, but they're still maybe a few stray mosquitoes that wander into your outdoor living space. That's handy to take care of them, but what we learned with the handheld insect zapper is it's actually a really great tool to use when you're actually maintaining your unit. It's because when you get over here by the unit there's a ton of mosquitoes swarming around it, and that's how it's supposed to be. With the handheld insect zapper you can take that and just wave it around your unit and zap any of the mosquitoes that are immediately in the area. And then you can easily and mosquito-free work on your unit. You may have to wave that a couple of times unless you turn your unit off, but it's recommended to keep it running 24/7.
