



Hi, I'm Melissa from NorthlineExpress, and I'm here to talk to you about a great firepit accessory for your backyard fires. This is the FIREase IncinerGrate, as I like to call it, the teepee grate. What it's designed to do is help you easily stack your firewood in that teepee formation for the best burn possible in your outdoor fire, and it's going to help keep it in that teepee formation throughout the burn as well, so your fire doesn't collapse, and ultimately you're spending less time tending and setting up your fire, and more time enjoying it. It's a really simple product to use.

As you can see, it's going to come fully assembled. It's made with square steel, so it's going to be durable and withstand the outdoors, but it's also small enough that it's lightweight and portable, so you can keep it in your camper and take it with you on camping trips and use it in a variety of different sized fire pits. As you can see, the one I've got in front of me here today is rather large, but that doesn't mean the IncinerGrate is not going to work for you.

It's very easy to use, you're simple going to set it into place, make sure you've got a kind of level spot going on here. Of course, I don't. So I'm just going to get it as good as I can in here. Once you got it set in place, what you're going to want to do next is start putting your firewood around it. As you can see, it's designed with these grooves, so all you really do is set your firewood in place. That's what I love about it, because I know if you're anything like me, every time I try to build the teepee in my fire pit to get a good fire going, I get it just right, and that last piece of wood is always what tumbles the thing down.

So, once you've got your first few pieces of firewood in place, what you'll going to do next is get your fire starter. You can use some sort of tinder, some twigs or some leaves, but I'm going to use some Rutland Safe Life fire starters. They're my favorite because they work, really easy to light, and even if they get a little bit damp or wet, they're still going to light, no problem. So, take a few of those, and what you're going to going to do is set them on place underneath the grate, where you see there's that triangle area.

That's going to allow the fire starter to burn up and catch your firewood on fire. There's also a place up here on top, if you've got more of a tender, more of leaves or twigs, you can set them on top as well, and use fire starters up here on top to get your fire accelerated even faster.

Once you get your fire starters lit, you're just going to set them into place underneath there, and I'm going to use my other fire starter to get the next one going. I'm going to set that one up on the upper piece to show you how you can use that area too to get your fire going. And now, I'm going to put my other piece of wood in place. And you can use more pieces of wood than this, I'm just doing this for demo purposes, so I going to show you how it's going to look with minimal wood. Now, really all I have to do is sit and wait, and it's going to ignite that fire. The nice thing about this, besides the fact that it's easy to set up your teepee and use it every time, is look at how much air flow your fire can get. Just like if you're burning in a wood stove or a fireplace in your home, air flow to that fire is vital, it's what's going to make that fire grow, and as you can see, my fire wood is already starting to catch, and we're going to enjoy a beautiful fire.

So, as you can see, it really is a very simple process. With the teepee, or FIREASE IncinerGrate , all you really have to do is set it in place. There's no more struggling with stacking that teepee, set your fire starters underneath, and let the grate do the rest. That increased airflow, that supported by the teepee formation of the fire wood, is going to really help get that fire started way faster and then it's also going to help support that teepee formation so that it's going to burn better, stronger, and longer. And that also means less time messing around with the fire, and more time enjoying your friends and family around an outdoor campfire.
