



Hi, I'm Melissa from NorthlineExpress and I love outdoor fires. But one thing I don't like about outdoor fires is getting them started. And one thing I've learned over the years that the best way to get a fire going fast and keep it going a long time is air flow. Usually, to get that optimum air flow the best way to do it is to stack it in a teepee formation but if you're anything like me by the third time I've stacked that all up and then knocked it all down I'm just not in the mood for a fire anymore.

That's why I've got a great outdoor accessory for your fire pit that I'd love to tell you about today. That's the Spider fire pick grate by Custom Fire Screen. It's an American made handcrafted grate that is durable. It's made with three quarter inch square steel bars so it's going to be durable and last a long time in your fire pit and most importantly it's going to get those fires going faster for you and keep that air flow for your fire pit which is vital to keep a fire going for a long time without a lot of tending.

The way this fire pit works as you can see it's in a circular shape so it's going to fit into most round fire pits outdoors. It'll fit into square ones too as long as you choose the right size. There are two sizes of fire pit. This is our smaller version, the 23 inch Spider grate which is going to fit in 23 to 29 inch sized fire pits. Then we've also got a larger version that I'm using here in the fire pit which is our 29 inch which is going to fit fire pits that are 29 inches and up.

Whatever size fire pit you've got we've got a Spider grate for you. The way this grate is going to help your fire is it's going to allow that optimal air flow to get into your fire and help it burn stronger longer. It does that just like a fireplace grate would inside your fireplace in your home. What you'll notice here is that this fire pit grate has a four inch lift on it. That four inch lift is going to allow for lots of air flow into your fire pit and to keep that fire going. It's also a tip here, a great place to get your fire going.

Start your fire starters underneath. Stack your one on top and you're going to have that fire going in a matter of minutes. Another way you could do it is stack your fire starters here, put your firewood on top

and do the same thing. Really it's a preference thing and it's up to you. But both ways get the fire started super easy and keep it going for a long time.

Using a fire pit grate in your fire pit is not only going to enhance the look of your fire pit and make it look that much more classy but it's also going to like I mentioned earlier keep that fire going and there's going to be less tending to it because even if it starts to collapse on itself that air flow can still get to it. This burning season make sure you wow your friends, family, and neighbors with how easy you can get your fire going and keep it going without having to tend it every few minutes with a Spider fire pit grate from NorthlineExpress.
