



Hi, I'm Melissa from NorthlineExpress here to talk about our last and final step, Step 4 in our ultimate mosquito control process. Step 4 is to use personal mosquito repellents. With our variety of personal mosquito repellents there's no excuse for you to be outside being mosquito bait. And there's especially no excuse for you to not enjoy the outdoors wherever you go, because all of these personal mosquito products are great for you to use while you're in your 4 step mosquito zone, but they're also portable and easy to take with you so you can be mosquito-free wherever you go.

The mosquito personal repellents that we offer are as versatile as you are. We offer simple mosquito wipes, sprays, patches, and we get a little but more tech-y with the misting lanterns and the tabletop mosquito repellent products. I'm going to go into a little bit of detail about each particular product so you can choose the product that's going to work for you. Most of these products are all-natural and they don't use any chemicals, so that's a great bonus as well.

These are the liquid matte towelettes. They're all-natural so they're perfect for use on children and they're going to be safe to use as well; you don't have to worry about any harmful chemicals such as DEET. They're easy to use, they come in a nice, resealable portable package so you can throw them in your purse, keep them in your car: Wherever you need mosquito control, these will work. Then we've also got our mosquito patch which is also DEET free. It's easy to use; you stick it right on your arm and let the mosquito control begin.

Then, of course, there's the old-fashioned spray. Now, unlike other sprays out there on the market, this is liquid net, so it's also 100% all-natural, so you can spray away without the worry about the chemicals. Safe for use on children as well as pets, that's nice.

Now, let's get into the little bit more high-tech ones. These don't require you putting any types of products on, you don't have to wear a pad or patch; you don't have to do anything. You pretty much set it. It's going to provide a coverage zone.

This is the Terminix misting lantern, which is going to use a misting repellent. It's going to spray that out, and you have a remote so you can control how often and how many times it's going to spray for you. This product uses an all-natural repellent to repel those mosquitoes, so again, no worry about the misting chemicals coming in and causing problems: There are no chemicals.

This is our ThermaCell lantern. I love this product, personally use it. Great product. It runs off butane so you can take it with you. It's also a lantern, so I don't know if you can see it very well there in the video, but it's actually going to provide light. So, it's perfect to take camping or if you go on walks or just use out on your patio like I'm doing here today.

These are also good products; this is the Sidekick. It uses citronella and it's also all-natural, so you just clip it onto your belt or somewhere onto your person, and use it while you're outdoors gardening, going for a walk, or just relaxing on the patio. And this is our tabletop version of the Sidekick. It uses the same product, the citronella as well. It's all-natural. You set it on your tabletop, turn it on, and it's going to provide you with a mosquito free zone that you can enjoy.
